1 AN ACT concerning				
Health Occupations - Dental Hygienists - Supervised Practice in a Private Dental Office				
FOR the purpose of authorizing a dental hygienist practicing with a general license to practice under the supervision of a licensed dentist who is not on the premises while the authorized dental hygiene services are being performed; authorizes authorizing a dental hygienist practicing under a general license to practice dental hygiene under the supervision of a licensed dentist in a private dental office; requiring a private dental office supervising a dental hygienist to ensure certain licensing requirements are met; authorizing a dental hygienist to perform dental hygiene services without the supervising dentist on the premises only if certain requirements are met; prohibiting a supervising dentist from employing more than two dental hygienists to work under the dentist's general supervision at any given time; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the supervised practice of dental hygienists in a private dental office.
