- 23 BREWED UNDER THIS LICENSE TO CUSTOMERS FOR CONSUMPTION OFF THE
- 24 LICENSED PREMISES IN NONREFILLABLE CONTAINERS OR REFILLABLE
- 25 CONTAINERS THAT ARE SEALED BY THE MICRO-BREWERY LICENSEE AT THE TIME
- 26 OF EACH REFILL.
