17 (H) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, IN GARRETT 18 COUNTY, IF AT A PUBLIC SALE OF ANY SURPLUS REAL PROPERTY THE PUBLIC SALE 19 FAILS TO YIELD ANY BIDS FOR THAT PROPERTY, THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

- 1 (II) MAY PRIVATELY NEGOTIATE AND SELL THE SURPLUS
