- 3 FOR the purpose of broadening the scope of the wine tasting license in Garrett
- 4 County to allow beer tasting under certain circumstances; requiring the Board
- 5 of License Commissioners to regulate the quantity of beer to be served to each
- 6 person and the number of bottles from which the quantity is to be served; and

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 17 8-406.1.
- 18 (a) (1) In Garrett County, the Board of License Commissioners may issue a 19 wine AND BEER tasting alcoholic beverages license.
- 20 (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Board may issue a 21 license only to holders of a beer, wine and liquor license or a beer and wine license.
- 22 (3) The license permits the consumption of wine OR BEER authorized to
- 23 be sold by the beer, wine and liquor license or the beer and wine license for tasting or
- 24 sampling purposes only and for which no consideration may be charged or exacted.
- 25 (4) The Board of License Commissioners shall regulate:
- 26 (i) The quantity of wine OR BEER to be served to each person; and

- 1 (ii) The number of bottles of wine OR BEER from which this 2 quantity is being served.
- 3 (5) The annual license fee is \$100 in addition to the cost of the beer, wine 4 and liquor license or the beer and wine license.
- 5 (6) The privileges granted by this wine AND BEER tasting license may 6 not be exercised during the Maryland Wine Festival.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 June 1, 2003.
