A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Education - Principals - State Salary Grants

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a State program of salary grants for principals,
- 4 vice-principals, and assistant principals; stating the purpose of the program;
- authorizing county boards of education to submit applications for a State grant
- 6 under the program; requiring an application for a State grant to contain certain
- 7 information and be in a certain format; requiring that a State grant be awarded
- 8 for a certain fiscal year to a county board that applies and establishes certain
- 9 aggregate salary adjustments over a certain time period for principals,
- vice-principals, and assistant principals; establishing a formula to determine
- the amount of a State grant; establishing certain requirements for the funds
- provided by a county board for salary adjustments; requiring State grants under
- the program to be used to provide an additional cost-of-living adjustment for
- principals, vice-principals, and assistant principals for a certain fiscal year;
- requiring the Governor to include certain funds in the State budget for the
- program; authorizing the Department of Budget and Management and the State
- 17 Superintendent to adopt certain regulations or guidelines; defining certain
- 18 terms; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to a State
- 19 program of salary grants for principals, vice-principals, and assistant

- 26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Education** 2 5-213.1. IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 3 (A) (1) 4 INDICATED. "COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT" MEANS A PERCENTAGE 5 (I) (2) 6 INCREASE IN SALARIES AND WAGES THAT APPLIES AMONG ALL GRADES AND STEPS. "COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT" DOES NOT INCLUDE SALARY (II)8 INCREASES FOR PROMOTIONS, INCREMENTS, OR STEP INCREASES, OR SIMILAR 9 SALARY INCREASES RECEIVED IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF A PERSONNEL SYSTEM. "PROGRAM" MEANS THE PROGRAM OF SALARY GRANTS FOR 11 PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, AND ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS. "SALARY BASE" MEANS THE TOTAL SALARIES AND WAGES OF 12 13 PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, AND ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS EMPLOYED BY A 14 COUNTY BOARD, AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND 15 MANAGEMENT AND THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT. THERE IS A PROGRAM OF SALARY GRANTS FOR PRINCIPALS, 16 (B) 17 VICE-PRINCIPALS, AND ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS IN THE STATE. (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO COUNTY 18 19 BOARDS THAT INCREASE THE SALARIES OF PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, AND 20 ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS WITH THE GOAL OF IMPROVING RECRUITMENT AND 21 RETENTION OF WELL QUALIFIED PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, AND ASSISTANT 22 PRINCIPALS. ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2003, EACH COUNTY BOARD MAY 23 (D) 24 SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND 25 MANAGEMENT AND THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT. THE APPLICATION SHALL INCLUDE: 26 (2) 27 (I) THE ESTIMATED SALARY BASE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004; FOR FISCAL YEARS 2002, 2003, AND 2004, THE AGGREGATE 28 (II)29 ADJUSTMENTS NEGOTIATED AND FUNDED UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS 30 SECTION, TO BE FUNDED FROM SOURCES OTHER THAN THE STATE GRANT, 31 EXPRESSED IN TOTAL DOLLARS AND AS A PERCENTAGE: AND 32 (III)ANY OTHER INFORMATION NECESSARY TO DETERMINE 33 ELIGIBILITY FOR A GRANT. 34 THE APPLICATION SHALL BE IN A FORMAT SPECIFIED BY THE (3) 35 DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT AND THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT.

- 1 (E) (1) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005, A STATE GRANT SHALL BE AWARDED UNDER 2 THE PROGRAM TO EACH COUNTY BOARD THAT:
- 3 (I) SUBMITS AN APPLICATION; AND
- 4 (II) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND AS
- 5 DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT AND THE STATE
- 6 SUPERINTENDENT, PROVIDES IN FISCAL YEARS 2002, 2003, AND 2004 NEGOTIATED
- 7 AND FUNDED:
- 8 1. COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS FOR PRINCIPALS,
- $9\ \ VICE\text{-}PRINCIPALS, AND\ ASSISTANT\ PRINCIPALS\ THAT\ AGGREGATE\ TO\ AT\ LEAST\ 4\%;$
- 10 OR
- 11 2. ADJUSTMENTS TO THE SALARY SCHEDULES FOR
- 12 PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, AND ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS THAT HAVE AN
- 13 AGGREGATE COST THAT IS AT LEAST EQUAL TO THE COST OF PROVIDING A 4%
- 14 COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT FOR PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, AND ASSISTANT
- 15 PRINCIPALS.
- 16 (2) THE FUNDS PROVIDED BY A COUNTY BOARD UNDER THIS
- 17 SUBSECTION SHALL BE:
- 18 (I) IN ADDITION TO ANY STEP INCREASES AND STIPENDS
- 19 NEGOTIATED AND FUNDED BEFORE FISCAL YEAR 2002; AND
- 20 (II) OBTAINED FROM SOURCES OTHER THAN A PROGRAM GRANT.
- 21 (F) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005, IF A COUNTY BOARD COMPLIES WITH SUBSECTION
- 22 (E) OF THIS SECTION, A STATE GRANT MADE TO A COUNTY BOARD UNDER THE
- 23 PROGRAM SHALL BE THE PRODUCT OF THE SALARY BASE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004
- 24 MULTIPLIED BY 0.01.
- 25 (G) A STATE GRANT MADE UNDER THE PROGRAM SHALL BE USED TO PROVIDE
- 26 AN ADDITIONAL 1% COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT FOR PRINCIPALS,
- 27 VICE-PRINCIPALS, AND ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS IN FISCAL YEAR 2005.
- 28 (H) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE FUNDS IN THE STATE BUDGET TO
- 29 IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM.
- 30 (I) THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT AND THE STATE
- 31 SUPERINTENDENT MAY ADOPT GUIDELINES OR REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE
- 32 PROGRAM.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 34 July 1, 2003. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June
- 35, 30, 2005, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
- 36 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
