- 1 (E) A PERSON IN POSSESSION OF A PERMIT IS NOT REQUIRED TO POSSESS A
- 2 MARYLAND COMMERCIAL FISHING GUIDE LICENSE UNDER § 4-210 OF THIS SUBTITLE
- 3 TO OPERATE A CHARTER BOAT IN TIDAL WATERS OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY IN
- 4 MARYLAND.
- 5 (F) A PERSON OPERATING A CHARTER BOAT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
- 6 SECTION MUST SHALL HAVE ALL APPROPRIATE FEDERAL AND STATE LICENSES AND
- 7 THE REQUIRED PERMIT IN POSSESSION WHENEVER OPERATING A CHARTER BOAT.
- 8 (G) THE HOLDER OF A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO
- 9 THE PENALTIES UNDER SUBTITLE 12 OF THIS TITLE.
