- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Criminal Law
- 14 12-103.1.
- 15 (A) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE, A PERSON MAY NOT
- 16 CONDUCT A CASINO EVENT AT WHICH A CARD GAME, DICE GAME, OR ROULETTE IS
- 17 PLAYED AND MONEY OR TOKENS REDEEMABLE IN MONEY ARE AWARDED AS PRIZES.
- 18 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 19 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A
- 20 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 2003.
