- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 9-1306.
- 16 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO DRILLS A WELL TO
- 17 CONDUCT TEMPORARY DEWATERING BY USE OF WELL POINTS, DEEP WELLS, OR
- 18 SIMILAR METHODS OF DEWATERING TO INSTALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES OR
- 19 INSTALL, CONSTRUCT, OR RECONSTRUCT FOOTINGS, PILINGS, ABUTMENTS, OR
- 20 FOUNDATIONS IN CONNECTION WITH HEAVY OR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION.
- 21 (B) A person may not drill a well in this State unless the Department issues a
- 22 permit to drill the well.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take
- 24 effect October 1, 2003.
