2 Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages - Stadium License

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Frederick County Board of License
- 4 Commissioners to issue a stadium on-sale license to a certain person;
- 5 authorizing the holder of a stadium license to sell beer and light wine during
- 6 events in a certain stadium under certain conditions; setting a license fee;
- 7 providing that a certain privilege is not part of a certain license; making this Act
- 8 an emergency measure; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in
- 9 Frederick County.
- 10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 11 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 12 Section 8-211.1

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

18 8-211.1.

- 19 (a) The Frederick County Board of License Commissioners may issue a
- 20 stadium [beer] on-sale license to the owner of any professional baseball team
- 21 franchise, whether the franchise is a partnership, corporation, or limited liability
- 22 company.
- 23 (b) The stadium [beer] on-sale license authorizes the holder to sell beer AND
- 24 LIGHT WINE at the stadium in which the baseball team plays its home games only
- 25 under the following circumstances:
- 26 (1) In plastic, styrofoam, or paper containers on the stadium premises;
- 27 (2) For consumption on the licensed premises;

- 1 (3) To persons present at [a baseball game in which the licensee's team 2 is playing] ANY EVENT HELD IN THE STADIUM; and
- 3 (4) From the time the stadium opens for the [game] EVENT until the 4 [game] EVENT ends.
- 5 (c) The annual fee for the stadium [beer] on-sale license is [\$500] \$2,000.
- 6 (d) Except for a manufacturer or distributor of beer who is conducting 7 business with the licensee for purposes of this section, the licensee may not permit 8 any person to:
- 9 (1) Carry any alcoholic beverages onto the licensed premises; or
- 10 (2) Carry any alcoholic beverages from the licensed premises.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the privilege to sell beer
- 12 and light wine at an event held in the stadium is not considered to be part of a
- 13 separate license and, if the privilege is granted, it shall be incorporated into a
- 14 stadium beer on-sale license existing before the effective date of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 16 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 17 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 18 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 19 the date it is enacted.
