	(2) <u>beginning July 1, 2003, member contributions to the Employees'</u> Pension System as provided in § 23-212 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article as an employee of the Board of License Commissioners of Washington County.
32	(2) (d) If a retiree who receives credit under this section waives payment of any contributions or interest, the Board of Trustees shall reduce the retiree's allowance by the actuarial equivalent of those contributions, plus interest to the date of retirement, that the retiree had not paid.
