2 Frederick County - Electric Generating Stations - Zoning Restrictions

- 3 FOR the purpose of creating in Frederick County an exception to the preemption of
- 4 local zoning laws regarding the construction and operation of electric generating
- 5 stations; authorizing in Frederick County certain property to be operated for
- 6 electric generating and associated on-site transmission purposes only if the use
- 7 complies with all local zoning rules, regulations, laws, and ordinances; requiring
- 8 that, before a person constructs a generating station in Frederick County, the
- 9 proposed construction comply with all applicable local zoning and subdivision
- rules and regulations; and generally relating to zoning for electric generating
- 11 stations in Frederick County.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 Article - Natural Resources

- 25 3-306.1.
- 26 (A) In view of the safeguards provided by this subtitle through State units,
- 27 and to assure the controlling effect of their determinations, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN
- 28 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, any property certified as a suitable site by the

- 1 Secretary of Natural Resources and placed in inventory as provided in this subtitle or
- 2 any sites acquired and placed in inventory as provided in this subtitle shall be used
- 3 and operated for electric generating and associated on-site transmission purposes
- 4 without regard to any local zoning rule, regulation, law, or ordinance, and this use is
- 5 not required to be submitted to or approved by any county or municipal zoning board,
- 6 authority, or unit.
- 7 (B) IN FREDERICK COUNTY, A PROPERTY CERTIFIED AS A SUITABLE SITE BY
- 8 THE SECRETARY UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AND PLACED IN INVENTORY OR A SITE
- 9 ACQUIRED AND PLACED IN INVENTORY UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE OPERATED
- 10 FOR ELECTRIC GENERATING AND ASSOCIATED ON-SITE TRANSMISSION PURPOSES
- 11 ONLY IF THE USE COMPLIES WITH ALL LOCAL ZONING RULES, REGULATIONS, LAWS,
- 12 AND ORDINANCES.

- 15 (b) (1) (i) [Unless] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN ITEM (II) OF THIS
- 16 PARAGRAPH, UNLESS a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the
- 17 construction is first obtained from the Commission, a person may not begin
- 18 construction in the State of a generating station.
- 19 (II) IN FREDERICK COUNTY, A PERSON MAY NOT CONSTRUCT A
- 20 GENERATING STATION UNLESS:
- 21 1. THE PERSON FIRST OBTAINS A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
- 22 CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION FROM THE COMMISSION;
- 23 AND
- 24 2. THE CONSTRUCTION COMPLIES WITH ALL APPLICABLE
- 25 LOCAL ZONING AND SUBDIVISION RULES AND REGULATIONS.
- 26 [(ii)] (III) If a person obtains Commission approval for construction
- 27 under § 7-207.1 of this subtitle, the Commission shall exempt a person from the
- 28 requirement to obtain a certificate of public convenience and necessity under this
- 29 section.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 July 1, 2003.
