- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALLEGANY COUNTY MAY PROVIDE
- 19 THAT, WITH THE WRITTEN APPROVAL OF A MAJORITY OF THE RESIDENTS AFFECTED,
- 20 THE COUNTY UTILITIES DIVISION MAY ASSESS A FEE TO ACQUIRE AND OPERATE
- 21 EXISTING STREETLIGHTS THAT ARE SITUATED IN AN AREA SERVICED BY THE
- 22 UTILITIES DIVISION.
- 23 (B) WHILE UNPAID, THE FEES ASSESSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION
- 24 (A) OF THIS SECTION ARE A LIEN ON THE PROPERTY SERVED.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2003.
