- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Commercial Law
- 15 14-1319.
- 16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "GIFT CERTIFICATE" INCLUDES A GIFT CARD OR OTHER
- 17 DOCUMENT OR DEVICE WITH AN INTENDED CASH VALUE TO EVIDENCE A GIFT FROM
- 18 THE PURCHASER TO A THIRD PARTY USABLE ON ITS FACE AMOUNT IN EXCHANGE
- 19 FOR GOODS OR SERVICES.
- 20 (B) A GIFT CERTIFICATE, GIFT CARD, OR OTHER SIMILAR DEVICE ISSUED TO A
- 21 CONSUMER MAY NOT EXPIRE PRIOR TO ITS USE.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing
- 23 obligation or contract right may not be impaired in any way by this Act.
- 24 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 25 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
- 26 any effect on or application to any gift certificate issued before the effective date of
- 27 this Act.

- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2003.
