10 (i) "Program" means the Maryland Medical Assistance Program.

12 (a) The Department shall adopt rules and regulations for the reimbursement

13 of providers under the Program. However, except for an invoice that must be

14 submitted to a Medicare intermediary or Medicare carrier for an individual who may

15 have both Medicare and Medicaid coverage, payment may not be made for an invoice

16 that is received more than 1 year after the dates of the services given.

ELECTRONICALLY TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER § 15-105(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THEN
THE PHARMACY MAY CHOOSE TO BE REIMBURSED ELECTRONICALLY, AND IN THAT
EVENT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REIMBURSE THE PHARMACY ELECTRONICALLY
UNDER THE PROGRAM.
