3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of members that may be on planning
4 commissions created under a certain statutory law; making technical changes;
5 and generally relating to the membership of planning commissions.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 66B - Land Use**

14 3.02.

15 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this article, a planning commission
16 created under this subtitle shall consist of [either] THREE, [five or] FIVE, OR seven
17 members.

18 (2) One of the members may be a member of the local legislative body,
19 serving in an ex officio capacity concurrent with the member's official term.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
21 effect October 1, 2003.
