3 4 5 6	FOR the purpose of prohibiting real estate brokers and salespersons from charging a certain type of fee; requiring the State Real Estate Commission to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the prohibition against charging transaction fees by real estate brokers and salespersons.
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12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
14	<b>Article - Business Occupations and Professions</b>

16 17	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "TRANSACTION FEE" MEANS A SURCHARGE TO A HOME SELLER OR A HOME BUYER IN EXCESS OF THE SALES COMMISSION.
18 19	(2) "TRANSACTION FEE" INCLUDES AN ADMINISTRATION FEE OR A REGULATORY COMPLIANCE FEE.
20	(B) (1) A REAL ESTATE BROKER MAY NOT CHARGE A TRANSACTION FEE.
21 22	(2) A REAL ESTATE SALESPERSON MAY NOT CHARGE A TRANSACTION FEE.
23 24	(C) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.
25	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
