## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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### **Real Property - Ground Rents - Reimbursement for Expenses**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that a holder of a ground rent is entitled to

- 4 reimbursement for certain expenses not exceeding a certain amount incurred in
- 5 collecting a certain past due ground rent and complying with certain notice
- 6 requirements; providing that a certain plaintiff or holder of a ground rent is
- 7 entitled to reimbursement for certain reasonable expenses incurred in the
- 8 preparation and filing of a certain action for ejectment; defining a certain term;
- 9 providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to ground rents.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 8-402.3 of Article Real Property of the Annotated
- 23 Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 8-402.4.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 25 read as follows: 1

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#### **Article - Real Property**

2 8-402.3.

3 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "GROUND RENT" MEANS A RESIDENTIAL LEASE OR
4 SUBLEASE IN EFFECT ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2003, THAT HAS AN INITIAL TERM OF 99
5 YEARS RENEWABLE FOREVER AND CREATES A LEASEHOLD ESTATE SUBJECT TO THE
6 PAYMENT OF AN ANNUAL LEASE AMOUNT.

7 (B) (1) A HOLDER OF A GROUND RENT THAT IS AT LEAST 6 MONTHS IN
8 ARREARS IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES NOT EXCEEDING \$500
9 INCURRED IN THE COLLECTION OF THAT PAST DUE GROUND RENT AND IN
10 COMPLYING WITH THE NOTICE REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 8-402.2(A) OF THIS
11 SUBTITLE, INCLUDING:

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(I) TITLE ABSTRACT AND EXAMINATION FEES;

13 (II) JUDGMENT REPORT FEES;

14 (III) PHOTOCOPYING AND POSTAGE FEES; AND

15 (IV) ATTORNEY'S FEES.

16 (2) UPON FILING AN ACTION FOR EJECTMENT UNDER § 8-402.2 OF THIS
17 SUBTITLE, THE PLAINTIFF OR HOLDER OF A GROUND RENT IS ENTITLED TO
18 REIMBURSEMENT FOR REASONABLE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PREPARATION
19 AND FILING OF THE EJECTMENT ACTION, INCLUDING:

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(I) FILING FEES AND COURT COSTS;

21 (II) EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE SERVICE OF PROCESS;

22 (III) TITLE ABSTRACT AND EXAMINATION FEES NOT INCLUDED 23 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION;

24 (IV) ATTORNEY'S FEES NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000, UNLESS THE COURT 25 APPROVES A GREATER AMOUNT; AND

26 (V) TAXES, INCLUDING INTEREST AND PENALTIES, THAT HAVE 27 BEEN PAID BY THE PLAINTIFF OR HOLDER OF A GROUND RENT.

28 (C) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION OR IN §
29 8-402.2(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE PLAINTIFF OR HOLDER OF A GROUND RENT IS NOT
30 ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR ANY OTHER EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE
31 COLLECTION OF A GROUND RENT.

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be

33 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have

34 any effect on or application to any suit, action, or proceeding before the effective date

35 of this Act.

## SENATE BILL 439

- 1 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 2003.
