- 4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 5 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 8 (b) (2) A local governing body shall prepare a local land preservation and
- 9 recreation plan with acquisition goals based upon the most current population data
- 10 available from the Department of Planning and submit it to the Department and to
- 11 the Department of Planning for joint approval according to the criteria and goals set
- 12 forth in [the Maryland Land Preservation and Recreation Plan and any revisions
- 13 thereof] GUIDELINES PREPARED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 14 PLANNING. A local governing body shall revise its local land preservation and
- 15 recreation plan at least every [five] SIX years [concurrently with the revision of the
- 16 Maryland Land Preservation and Recreation Plan] and submit the revised local plan
- 17 to the Department and to the Department of Planning for joint approval ONE YEAR
- 18 PRIOR TO THE REVISION OF THE MARYLAND LAND PRESERVATION AND RECREATION
- 19 PLAN. Prior to approval of a revised local plan, the Department shall provide the
- 20 legislators from the district within which any part of the local jurisdiction is located
- 21 the opportunity to review and comment on the revised local plan.

- 23 (b) Every acquisition and development project funded by the State in whole or
- 24 in part shall meet needs identified in the Maryland Land Preservation and
- 25 Recreation Plan prepared and revised every [5] 6 YEARS [years, beginning in 1993,]
- 26 by the Department of Planning in cooperation with the Department. The document
- 27 shall identify and recommend for State acquisition efforts those resource areas facing
- 28 the most intense or immediate development pressure. These resource areas shall be
- 29 designated as targeted areas. The document and any changes to it shall be distributed
- 30 to every local governing body.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- 32 (a) A local land preservation and recreation plan shall be submitted to the
- 33 Department of Natural Resources and the Department of Planning by July 1, 2005.
- 34 (b) The Maryland Land Preservation and Recreation Plan shall be prepared
- 35 and revised by the Department of Planning by July 1, 2006.
- 36 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 37 October 1, 2003.
