Chapter 231 of the Acts of 2001

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:

15 Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the (5)purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a 16 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either 17 18 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or 19 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds 20 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount 21 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the 22 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. 23 The grantee has until June 1, [2003] 2005, to present evidence satisfactory to the 24 Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence 25 is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to 26 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching 27 fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan 28 in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works

29 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
