- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 14 19-1801.
- 15 In this subtitle:
- 16 (1) "Assisted living program" means a residential or facility-based
- 17 program that provides housing and supportive services, supervision, personalized
- 18 assistance, health-related services, or a combination [thereof] OF THOSE SERVICES
- 19 TO SIX OR MORE INDIVIDUALS that meets the needs [of individuals who] FOR THOSE
- 20 WHO are unable to perform or who need assistance in performing the activities of
- 21 daily living or instrumental activities of daily living in a way that promotes optimum
- 22 dignity and independence for the individuals.
- 23 (2) "ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM" INCLUDES AN ASSISTED LIVING
- 24 PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES THE SERVICES LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS
- 25 SECTION TO FIVE OR FEWER INDIVIDUALS IF THE ACTIONS OF THE ASSISTED LIVING
