- 15 (e) (1) On completion of a continuing education course by a licensee, the
- 16 entity that conducted the course or the instructor shall issue to the licensee a
- 17 certificate of completion that states the number of clock hours of that course.
- 18 (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL ACCEPT AS EVIDENCE OF COMPLETION OF
- 19 A CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE THE CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION, A
- 20 PHOTOCOPY OF THE CERTIFICATE, AN ELECTRONIC MAIL CERTIFICATE, OR A
- 21 PHOTOCOPY OF AN ELECTRONIC MAIL CERTIFICATE.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 23 October 1, 2003.
