

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 6 7 read as follows: 8 **Article - Health Occupations** 9 1-101. 10 "PHARMACEUTICAL MANUFACTURING COMPANY" MEANS ANY 11 ENTITY THAT IS ENGAGED IN THE PRODUCTION, PREPARATION, PROPAGATION, 12 COMPOUNDING, CONVERSION, OR PROCESSING OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS: DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY BY EXTRACTION FROM SUBSTANCES 13 (I) 14 OR NATURAL ORIGIN; INDEPENDENTLY BY MEANS OF CHEMICAL SYNTHESIS; OR 15 (II)BY A COMBINATION OF EXTRACTION AND CHEMICAL (III) 17 SYNTHESIS. "PHARMACEUTICAL MANUFACTURING COMPANY" INCLUDES ANY 19 ENTITY ENGAGED IN THE PACKING, REPACKAGING, LABELING, RELABELING, OR 20 DISTRIBUTION OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS. 21 "PHARMACEUTICAL MANUFACTURING COMPANY" DOES NOT 22 INCLUDE A WHOLESALE DRUG DISTRIBUTOR OR PHARMACIST LICENSED UNDER 23 TITLE 12 OF THIS ARTICLE. "PHARMACEUTICAL MARKETER" MEANS A PERSON WHO, WHILE 24 25 EMPLOYED BY OR UNDER CONTRACT TO REPRESENT A PHARMACEUTICAL 26 MANUFACTURING COMPANY, ENGAGES IN PHARMACEUTICAL: 27 (I) DETAILING; 28 (II)PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES; OR MARKETING TO ANY PHYSICIAN, NURSE PRACTITIONER, 29 (III)30 PHARMACIST, HOSPITAL, NURSING HOME, OR OTHER PERSON AUTHORIZED TO 31 PRESCRIBE, DISPENSE, OR PURCHASE FOR RESALE OR DISTRIBUTION, ANY 32 PRESCRIPTION DRUG. 33 "PHARMACEUTICAL MARKETER" DOES NOT INCLUDE A WHOLESALE (2)34 DRUG DISTRIBUTOR.

- 11 (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-405 of this subtitle, the Board, on
- 12 the affirmative vote of a majority of its full authorized membership, may reprimand
- 13 any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the

- 15 (39) Intentionally misrepresents credentials for the purpose of testifying
- 16 or rendering an expert opinion in hearings or proceedings before the Board or those
- 17 otherwise delegated to the Office of Administrative Hearings; [or]
- 18 (40) Fails to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate
- 19 peer review; OR
- 20 (41) EXCEPT FOR PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCT SAMPLES AND
- 21 LITERATURE PERTAINING TO PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS, ACCEPTS ANY GIFT
- 22 GREATER THAN \$50 FROM A PHARMACEUTICAL MANUFACTURING COMPANY OR A
- 23 PHARMACEUTICAL MARKETER IN VIOLATION OF § 14-505.1 OF THIS TITLE.

- 25 EXCEPT FOR PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCT SAMPLES AND LITERATURE
- 26 PERTAINING TO PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS, A PHYSICIAN SUBJECT TO THIS TITLE
- 27 MAY NOT ACCEPT ANY GIFT GREATER THAN \$50 FROM A PHARMACEUTICAL
- 28 MANUFACTURING COMPANY OR A PHARMACEUTICAL MARKETER.
- 29 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 30 October 1, 2003.
