Sellinger Program. 10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Education 11 12 Section 17-104 13 Annotated Code of Maryland 14 (2001 Replacement Volume and 2002 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 17 **Article - Education** 18 17-104. 19 The Maryland Higher Education Commission shall compute the amount of 20 the annual apportionment for each institution that qualifies under this subtitle by 21 multiplying: 22 The SUM OF THE number of full-time equivalent students WHO ARE (1) 23 STATE RESIDENTS PLUS 0.75 TIMES THE NUMBER OF FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT 24 STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT STATE RESIDENTS enrolled at the institution during the fall 25 semester of the fiscal year preceding the fiscal year for which the aid apportionment 26 is made, as determined by the Maryland Higher Education Commission times; 27 (2)In each of fiscal years 2003 and 2004, an amount not less than (i)

28 14.3% of the State's General Fund per full-time equivalent student appropriation to

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- 1 the 4-year public institutions of higher education in this State for the preceding fiscal 2 year;
- 3 (ii) In fiscal year 2005, an amount not less than 15.2% of the State's
- 4 General Fund per full-time equivalent student appropriation to the 4-year public
- 5 institutions of higher education in this State for the preceding fiscal year; and
- 6 (iii) In fiscal year 2006 and each fiscal year thereafter, an amount
- 7 not less than 16% of the State's General Fund per full-time equivalent student
- 8 appropriation to the 4-year public institutions of higher education in this State for
- 9 the preceding fiscal year.
- 10 (b) Full-time equivalent students enrolled in seminarian or theological
- 11 programs shall be excluded from the computation required by subsection (a) of this
- 12 section.
- 13 (c) Payments of State general funds under Subtitle 3 of this title shall be
- 14 excluded from the computation required by subsection (a) of this section.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 October 1, 2003.
