5 FOR the purpose of requiring certain elected officials to appoint the members of the

Board of Trustees of the Enoch Pratt Free Library of Baltimore City; providing
 for the composition of the Board; requiring that each member of the Board

reside in Baltimore City; requiring certain members of the Board be appointed

9 from certain councilmanic districts and legislative districts; establishing term

10 limits for members of the Board; prohibiting the Board from establishing a

11 board of directors or management board or delegating certain powers or duties;

12 requiring the Board to meet at certain times; requiring that the Enoch Pratt

13 Free Library consist of certain branches; providing that the Enoch Pratt Free

14 Library is a public agency of Baltimore City and a State agency; providing that

15 this Act supersedes any contrary provisions of existing laws pertaining to the

16 Enoch Pratt Free Library; creating a Task Force to Study the Governing

17 <u>Governance and Fiscal Structure of the Enoch Pratt Free Library System:</u>

18 providing for the membership of the Task Force; requiring the members of the

19 Task Force to elect the chairman; providing the staffing for the Task Force;

20 prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving compensation; requiring

the Task Force to study the governing structure of the Enoch Pratt Free Library
 System for certain defects or impediments, including the established system for

22 appointing the board of directors and the board of trustees; requiring the Task

24 Force to study the fiscal structure of the Enoch Pratt Free Library System for

25 certain defects or impediments; requiring the Task Force to make certain
