- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (a) Two or more candidates [who] MAY FORM A SLATE IF THE
- 20 CANDIDATES:
- 21 (I) have established separate campaign finance entities [may form
- 22 a slate]; AND
- 23 (II) 1. HAVE FILED CERTIFICATES OF CANDIDACY FOR OFFICES
- 24 THAT ARE TO APPEAR ON THE SAME ELECTION BALLOT; OR
- 25 2. FILE STATEMENTS WITH THE STATE BOARD THAT THEY
- 26 ARE ELIGIBLE FOR AND INTEND TO FILE CERTIFICATES OF CANDIDACY FOR OFFICES
