### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

# School for the Blind each year; altering the calculation of the appropriation for the Maryland School for the Blind; defining a certain term; and generally relating to funding for the Maryland School for the Blind. Article - Education Section 8-310(a) and 8-317 Annotated Code of Maryland (2001 Replacement Volume and 2002 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Education** 15 8-310. Each county shall pay the Maryland School for the Blind [\$200 a year] AN 16 (a) 17 AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE LOCAL SHARE OF THE BASIC COST, AS DEFINED IN § 18 8-415(D)(1) OF THIS TITLE, for each blind child who is sent to the school from the 19 county EACH YEAR TO SUPPORT THE COST OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMMING. 20 8-317. 21 (a) (1)In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. "4-year average annual full-time equivalent enrollment" means: 22 (2)

23 The average number of students enrolled annually in grades (i)

24 prekindergarten through grade 12 at the Maryland School for the Blind during 4

1 One-half the average number of children served annually by (ii) 2 the Maryland School for the Blind's Early Intervention Program during 4 consecutive 3 school years as determined by dividing the program's aggregate monthly enrollment 4 during the 4-year period by the number of months school is in session during the 5 4-year period. "ANNUAL SALARY INCREASE" MEANS THE INCREASE IN THE 6 (3)7 AGGREGATE SALARIES OF TEACHERS AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL, AS 8 REQUIRED BY § 8-309 OF THIS SUBTITLE, FROM THE AGGREGATE SALARIES OF 9 TEACHERS AND RELATED PROFESSIONALS IN THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR COMPARED 10 TO THE SECOND PRIOR FISCAL YEAR. 11 (4)"Growth in the per pupil basic current expense figure" means the 12 change in the per pupil basic current expense figure from the prior fiscal year to the 13 current fiscal year divided by the per pupil basic current expense figure from the 14 prior fiscal year. 15 (5) "Per pupil basic current expense figure" means the figure [(4)]16 calculated for each fiscal year by the Department in accordance with § 5-202 of this 17 article. 18 Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, "prior year (6) [(5)]19 appropriation" means the State appropriation to the Maryland School for the Blind in the prior fiscal year less any funding provided under § 8-315 of this subtitle in the 20 21 prior fiscal year. 22 [(6)] (7)"Weighted enrollment growth" means the product of 0.2 times 23 the change in the 4-year average annual full-time equivalent enrollment from the 24 3rd through the 6th prior school years to the 2nd through the 5th prior school years 25 divided by the 4-year average annual full-time equivalent enrollment from the 3rd 26 through the 6th prior school years. 27 Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, the Maryland School (b) 28 for the Blind shall receive an appropriation equal to or greater than the sum of: 29 75% of the prior year appropriation multiplied by the product of: (1)30 (i) The sum of the weighted enrollment growth plus one; and The sum of the growth in the per pupil basic current expense 31 (ii) 32 figure plus one; [and] 25% of the prior year appropriation multiplied by the sum of the 33 (2)34 weighted enrollment growth plus one; AND 35 (3) 120% OF THE ANNUAL SALARY INCREASE. 36 (c) The "prior year appropriation" used to calculate the fiscal year 2000 37 appropriation to the Maryland School for the Blind shall be \$11,585,436.
