THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM OR THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AS
AGENTS OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL
TRANSFER TO THE ACCUMULATION FUND OF THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS'
RETIREMENT SYSTEM THE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS THAT WERE MADE TO THE
EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM ON
BEHALF OF THOSE MEMBERS WHO TRANSFERRED, PLUS THE INTEREST EARNED ON

(B) FOR MEMBERS WHO TRANSFER UNDER § 25-202 OF THIS SUBTITLE FROM
THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM OR THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AS
AGENTS OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL
TRANSFER TO THE ANNUITY SAVINGS FUND OF THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS'
RETIREMENT SYSTEM THE EMPLOYEE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT WERE MADE TO THE
EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM BY
THOSE MEMBERS WHO TRANSFERRED, PLUS THE INTEREST EARNED ON THOSE
CONTRIBUTIONS THROUGH THE DATE OF TRANSFER.

21 (a) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
22 A member may retire with a normal service retirement allowance if:

23 [(1)] (I) on or before the date of retirement, the member has at least 20 24 years of eligibility service;

25 [(2)] (II) for at least 5 years immediately before retirement, the member 26 was a security attendant at Clifton T. Perkins Hospital Center, a correctional officer 27 in any of the first six job classifications, or in a combination of these positions; and

28 [(3)] (III) the member completes and submits a written application to the 29 Board of Trustees stating the date when the member desires to retire.

30 (2) A MEMBER WHO IS AN AGENT OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND
31 PROBATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL
32 SERVICES MAY RETIRE WITH A NORMAL SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE IF:

33 (I) 1. ON OR BEFORE THE DATE OF RETIREMENT, THE MEMBER

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1 (b) On retirement under this section, a member is entitled to receive a normal 2 service retirement allowance that equals one fifty-fifth of the member's average final 3 compensation multiplied by the number of years of creditable service.

5 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this Part II of this 6 subtitle applies only to an allowance received by a former member, retiree, or 7 surviving beneficiary of a deceased member, former member, or retiree of:

8 (1) the Employees' Pension System if the deceased member, former 9 member, or retiree was an employee of a participating governmental unit or a former 10 participating governmental unit, other than Frederick County, that has withdrawn 11 while a member; [or]

12 (2) the Local Fire and Police System; OR

13 (3) THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' SYSTEM, IF THE DECEASED
14 MEMBER, FORMER MEMBER, OR RETIREE WAS AN AGENT OF THE DIVISION OF
15 PAROLE AND PROBATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND
16 CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

17 (b) This Part II of this subtitle does not apply to an allowance that is subject to 18 adjustment under Part II, Part IV, Part V, or Part VI of this subtitle.

20 (a) This Part III applies only to an allowance received by:

21 (1) a former member, retiree, or surviving spouse of a member:

(i) of the Correctional Officers' Retirement System WHO WAS NOT
 AN AGENT OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
 PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES;

25 (ii) of the Employees' Retirement System or the Teachers'
26 Retirement System who elected Selection A (Additional member contributions);

27 (iii) of the State Police Retirement System;

(iv) who transferred to the Local Fire and Police System from the
Employees' Retirement System; or

30 (v) who transferred to the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension

31 System from the Employees' Retirement System and had elected Selection A

32 (Additional member contributions); or

33 (2) a surviving beneficiary of a deceased former member or retiree34 described in item (1) of this subsection.

35 (b) This Part III does not apply to:

5 (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, this title applies to transfers from 6 a State or local retirement or pension system to another State or local retirement or 7 pension system only if:

8 (1) each system is operated on an actuarial basis; and

9 (2) under each system contributions that are computed to be sufficient to 10 provide the reserves needed to cover the benefits payable on account of the system's 11 members are made during the employment of members.

12 (b) This title does not apply to:

(1)

13 (1) a transfer to the Judges' Retirement System of the State of Maryland;

14 (2) a transfer to or from the Legislative Pension Plan of the State of
15 Maryland except to the extent provided by the Joint Resolution submitted to the
16 General Assembly by the General Assembly Compensation Commission under Article
17 III, § 15 of the Maryland Constitution;

18 (3) a transfer from the Employees' Retirement System of the State of
19 Maryland to the Employees' Pension System of the State of Maryland under § 22-212
20 or § 22-213 of this article;

21 (4) a transfer from the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of
22 Maryland to the Teachers' Pension System of the State of Maryland under § 22-212 or
23 § 22-213 of this article;

24 (5) a transfer between the Employees' Retirement System of the State of 25 Maryland and the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Maryland;

(6) a transfer between the Employees' Pension System of the State of
Maryland and the Teachers' Pension System of the State of Maryland if the member
is not subject to the contributory pension benefit under Title 23, Subtitle 2, Part II of
this article in the previous and current system; [or]

30 (7) a transfer between the Employees' Pension System of the State of 31 Maryland and the Teachers' Pension System of the State of Maryland if the member 32 is subject to the contributory pension benefit under Title 23, Subtitle 2, Part II of this 33 article in the previous and current system;

34(8)A TRANSFER BETWEEN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND35THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM IF THE MEMBER IS AN AGENT

1 OF THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 2 SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES; OR

3 (9) A TRANSFER BETWEEN THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM AND THE
4 CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM IF THE MEMBER IS AN AGENT OF
5 THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY
6 AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.
