2 Electric Utility Regulation - Standard Offer Service

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the date on which the obligation of an electric company to
- 4 provide standard offer service to residential and small commercial customers
- 5 ends; providing that the obligation of an electric company to provide certain
- 6 service to medium and large commercial customers and industrial customers
- 7 may end as specified in a certain agreement; specifying the rate for standard
- 8 offer service if a certain settlement agreement is in effect; specifying the rate for
- 9 standard offer service for any period in which a settlement agreement is not in
- effect and until a certain date; altering the date in which the obligation of an
- electric company to provide standard offer service is extended if the Public
- Service Commission makes a certain finding; authorizing an electric company to
- procure the electricity needed to satisfy the standard offer service obligation by
- entering into certain long-term contracts; and generally relating to electric

- 26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Public Utility Companies** 2 7-510. 3 Beginning on the initial implementation date, an electric company's (c) (1) 4 obligation to provide electricity supply and electricity supply service is stated by this 5 subsection. 6 Electricity supply purchased from a customer's electric company is 7 known as standard offer service. A customer is considered to have chosen the standard offer service if the customer: is not allowed to choose an electricity supplier under the phase 10 in of customer choice in subsection (a) of this section; 11 (ii) contracts for electricity with an electricity supplier and it is not 12 delivered; 13 cannot arrange for electricity from an electricity supplier; (iii) 14 does not choose an electricity supplier; (iv) 15 chooses the standard offer service; or (v) has been denied service or referred to the standard offer service 16 (vi) 17 by an electricity supplier in accordance with § 7-507(e)(6) of this subtitle. 18 UNLESS CONTINUED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS (3) (I) 19 PARAGRAPH, ANY OBLIGATION OF AN ELECTRIC COMPANY TO PROVIDE STANDARD 20 OFFER SERVICE TO MEDIUM AND LARGE COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS AND 21 INDUSTRIAL CUSTOMERS SHALL END ON THE LATER OF: 22 1.
