20 21 22 23	(b) (1) A paid police officer employed by an airport authority, a county, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, a municipality, or the State, A DEPUTY SHERIFF OF BALTIMORE CITY, a deputy sheriff of Montgomery County, or, subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, a Prince George's County deputy sheriff or Prince George's County correctional officer is presumed to be suffering from an occupational disease that was suffered in the line of duty and is compensable under this title if:

(2) (i) A Prince George's County deputy sheriff or Prince George's
 County correctional officer is entitled to the presumption under this subsection only
 to the extent that the individual suffers from heart disease or hypertension that is
 more severe than the individual's heart disease or hypertension condition existing
 prior to the individual's employment as a Prince George's County deputy sheriff or
 Prince George's County correctional officer.
