16 (a) (1) A person may not be required to perform or participate in, or refer to

- 17 any source for, any medical procedure that results in artificial insemination,
- 18 sterilization, [or] termination of pregnancy, OR DESTRUCTION OF A FERTILIZED
- 19 OVUM.
- 20 (2) The refusal of a person to perform or participate in, or refer to a 21 source for, these medical procedures may not be a basis for:

- 23 (ii) Disciplinary or other recriminatory action against the person.
