- 7 providing that the provisions of this Act apply only in Baltimore County; and

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 (A) The State Highway Administration, as to both State and county highways,19 and any local authority, as to any other highways under its jurisdiction, may:

20 (1) Designate through highways and place stop signs or yield signs at 21 specified entrances to them; or

22 (2) Designate any intersection as a stop intersection or as a yield 23 intersection and place stop signs or yield signs at one or more entrances to the 24 intersection.

25 (B) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE COUNTY.

### **SENATE BILL 654**

1 (2) THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION AS TO COUNTY HIGHWAYS, 2 AND ANY LOCAL AUTHORITY AS TO ANY OTHER HIGHWAYS UNDER ITS JURISDICTION 3 SHALL:

4 (I) DESIGNATE ALL "T" INTERSECTIONS AS STOP INTERSECTIONS; 5 AND

6 (II) PLACE A STOP SIGN AT EACH "T" INTERSECTION SO AS TO
7 REQUIRE A VEHICLE DRIVING ON THE HIGHWAY THAT INTERSECTS BUT DOES NOT
8 CROSS THE OTHER HIGHWAY TO STOP.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 10 effect October 1, 2003.
