12 12	WHEREAS, The General Assembly found in 2000 that maternal deaths were a serious public health concern that had a tremendous family and societal impact and that maternal deaths were significantly underestimated and inadequately documented, preventing efforts to identify and reduce or eliminate the causes of death; and
1′ 13	WHEREAS, The General Assembly also found in 2000 that the State did not have a process for the confidential identification, investigation, or dissemination of findings regarding maternal deaths and found a need to establish a maternal mortality review program to review maternal deaths and to develop strategies for the prevention of maternal deaths; and

WHEREAS, The General Assembly of Maryland enacted the Maternal Mortality Review Program on April 25, 2000; and

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- WHEREAS, The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene established the
- 2 Program to review maternal deaths and to develop strategies for the prevention of
- 3 maternal deaths in Maryland; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Program has successfully fulfilled its objectives; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Maternal deaths are still a serious public health concern, however,
