3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to adopt

4 <u>regulations to</u> establish zones by regulation in which a person may catch oysters

5 with a power dredge during a certain time period; requiring the Department to

6 establish certain harvest sanctuaries comprising a certain percentage of a

7 <u>certain area</u>; authorizing the Department by regulation to open or close any zone

8 <u>area within certain zones</u> for the catching of oysters by power dredging or the

9 conservation of oysters; prohibiting a certain zone from being established the

10 <u>application of this Act in certain areas; authorizing the Department to set</u>

11 certain minimum and maximum size limits and set a season, day, and time

12 when oysters may be harvested by power dredging; requiring the Department to

13 follow certain criteria when determining whether to open or close an oyster

14 power dredge zone; requiring the Department to design and implement a certain

15 program; requiring the Department to publish certain notice before taking

16 certain actions; requiring that certain established zones include certain

17 geographic areas; authorizing the Department to require a person who catches

18 oysters with a power dredge to complete and file certain reports; providing for

19 the termination of this Act; and generally relating to oysters and power

20 dredging.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 July 1, 2003. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of June
 30, 2008, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be
 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
