- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Education** 2 14-402. 3 (a) The government of St. Mary's College of Maryland is vested in the Board of 4 Trustees of St. Mary's College of Maryland. 5 14-404. 6 In addition to any other powers granted and duties imposed by this title, (a) 7 and subject to the provisions of Title 11 of this article and any other restrictions 8 expressly imposed by law or by any trust agreement involving a pledge of property or 9 money, the Board of Trustees is responsible for the governance and management of 10 the College, and has all the powers, rights, and privileges that go with that 11 responsibility, including the powers and duties set forth in this section. 12 (b) The Board of Trustees: 13 (1) Has the care, control, and management of the College and all of its 14 property and assets; 15 May not be superseded in its authority by any State agency or office 16 in managing the affairs of the College except as [expressly] provided for in this
