- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance to assist
- 5 certain physician assistants in the repayment of certain higher education loans;

30 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

31 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Education** 2 18-1502. 3 (a) There is a program of loan assistance repayment known as the Janet L. 4 Hoffman Loan Assistance Repayment Program in the State. 5 Subject to the provisions of subsection (c) AND (D) of this section, the Office (b) 6 of Student Financial Assistance shall assist in the repayment of the amount of any 7 higher education loan owed by an individual who: 8 Receives a graduate, professional, or undergraduate degree from: (1) 9 (i) A college or university in the State of Maryland; 10 (ii) A school of medicine: or 11 (iii) A school of law; 12 (2) Obtains eligible employment; 13 Receives an income that is less than the maximum eligible total (3) 14 income levels established by the Office, including any additional sources of income; 15 and 16 (4) Satisfies any other criteria established by the Office. 17 Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (b) of this section, the (c) (1) 18 Office shall assist in the repayment of the amount of any higher education loan owed 19 by a physician who engages in primary care in the State or by a medical resident 20 specializing in primary care who agrees to practice for at least 2 years as a primary 21 care physician in a geographic area of the State that has been designated by the 22 Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene as being medically underserved with the 23 funds transferred to the Office by the Comptroller under § 14-207(c)(2)(i) of the 24 Health Occupations Article. 25 (2) A physician who engages in primary care is not precluded from 26 receiving assistance from the Office under subsection (b) of this section. 27 Any unspent portions of the money that is transferred to the Office 28 for use under this section from the Physician Quality Assurance Fund may not be 29 transferred to or revert to the General Fund of the State, but shall remain in the 30 Fund maintained by the Office to administer these programs to assist physicians 31 engaged in primary care as specified in paragraph (1) of this subsection. 32 NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS (D) (1) 33 SECTION, THE OFFICE SHALL ASSIST IN THE REPAYMENT OF THE AMOUNT OF ANY 34 HIGHER EDUCATION LOAN OWED BY A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT WHO ENGAGES IN 35 PRIMARY CARE IN THE STATE WHO AGREES TO PRACTICE FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS AS
