- 1 (B) The County Commissioners of Allegany County AND GARRETT COUNTY 2 may exercise jurisdiction over the county sanitary commission IN EACH COUNTY, as
- 3 created under this Part III.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 5 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 6 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members 7 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 8 the date it is enacted.
