**Real Estate Licensees - Continuing Education Certificate of Completion**

This bill requires the Real Estate Commission to accept as evidence of completion of a continuing education course the certificate of completion, a photocopy of the certificate, an electronic mail certificate, or a photocopy of an electronic mail certificate.

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** The entity that offers the continuing education course or its instructor issues a certificate of completion to the licensee. Licensees must present the original certificate to the board as evidence of completion.
