## FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE

House Bill 101 Judiciary

(Delegate Vallario)

#### **Estates - Funeral Expenses**

This bill removes the requirement for a personal representative of a solvent estate to obtain a court order to pay funeral expenses above \$5,000 when a will does not expressly authorize it. The requirement would remain for insolvent estates.

The bill is to be construed prospectively and may not be applied to any estate of a decedent who dies before the bill's October 1, 2003 effective date.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The bill is procedural in nature and would not directly affect governmental finances.

## Analysis

**Current Law:** The funeral expense allowance for an estate is limited to \$5,000 unless the estate is solvent and a special order of the court has been obtained or the will expressly empowers the personal representative to pay expenses without a court order.
