Finance

State Highways - Designation - 175th Infantry Regiment Memorial Highway

This bill requires the State Highway Administration to designate the portion of North Point Boulevard (Route 151) in Baltimore County from the 2100 block to the Cove Road intersection as the 175th Infantry Regiment Memorial Highway.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Transportation Trust Fund expenditures would increase by \$2,000 to install two signs identifying the name of the road. These costs could be handled with existing resources. Revenues would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Several portions of highways in Maryland have been dedicated to veterans, including the Korean War Veterans' Memorial Highway on Interstate 70 (Chapter 512 of 2002), the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Highway on Route 157 (Chapter 32 of 2002), the Veterans of Foreign Wars Memorial Highway on Interstate 83 (Chapter 554 of 2001), and the Korean War Veterans' Memorial Highway on Route 43 (Chapter 180 of 2001).
