Calvert County - Code of Public Local Laws - Legalization

This bill legalizes the 2002 edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of Calvert County and any packet or loose-leaf supplement to the 2002 Code of Public Local Laws published by the Calvert County Commissioners.

Analysis

Background: Chapter 715 of 1985 legalized the current edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of Calvert County.

Calvert County is one of eight counties that operate under the commission form of government. Commission counties have limited powers and only those powers that are expressly delegated by the General Assembly. Legalizing changes to the Code of Public Local Laws prior to publication of a new compilation must receive approval of the General Assembly. Calvert County advises that funds have been appropriated for the publishing costs of the county's new edition of the Code of Public Local Laws.
