House Bill 1062 (Delegates Oaks and Redmer)

Health and Government Operations

Physical Therapists and Physical Therapist Assistants - Treatment - Number of Patients

This bill allows a physical therapist to evaluate and/or treat no more than four patients per clinical treatment hour, excluding group therapy. A physical therapy assistant may treat no more than four patients per clinical treatment hour, excluding group therapy.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill would not directly affect governmental operations or finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Potential meaningful impact for any physical therapists and physical therapy assistants who work in a private practice and could see an additional patient each hour.

Analysis

Current Law: Under State regulations, a physical therapist may not evaluate and/or treat more than three patients per clinical treatment hour, excluding group therapy. A physical therapy assistant may not treat more than three patients per clinical treatment hour, excluding group therapy.

Background: There are 7,726 licensed physical therapists and 1,868 licensed physical therapy assistants in Maryland.
