## **Analysis**

**Current Law:** None applicable.

**Background:** It is common practice for military organizations to issue service bars for individuals who have served in conflicts or have participated in other significant military

events as recognition for their service to their country. Chapter 103 of 2002 provided service bars to Maryland National Guard members who were ordered into active service in response to the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks.

**State Fiscal Effect:** The Maryland Military Department advises that no more than 1,000 members of the Maryland National Guard will be called into active service as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The cost to design and produce 1,000 service bars will total approximately \$2,000.
