General Assembly - Joint Technology Oversight Committee

This bill repeals the June 30, 2005 termination date of the Joint Technology Oversight Committee.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill's requirements could be handled with existing resources.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 11 of 2000 created the Joint Technology Oversight Committee composed of ten members of the General Assembly (five senators and five delegates) as part of the Maryland Uniform Computer Information Transactions Act. The committee is responsible for overseeing the implementation of the Act, which established rules governing sales and license agreements for computer information products.

The provisions establishing the committee became effective July 1, 2000 and sunset June 30, 2005. The law requires the Department of Legislative Services to provide staff for the committee.
