State Designations - Walking as the State Exercise

This bill designates walking as the State exercise.

Fiscal Summary

Current Law: There is not a State exercise designated in statute.

Background: Title 13 of the State Government Article lists various emblems and designations adopted by the State. In addition to the State flag and seal, the State has designated an official State cat, crustacean, bird, boat, dinosaur, dog, drink, fish, flower, folk dance, fossil shell, insect, reptile, song, sport, summer theater, theater, and tree.
