#### **Jury Duty - Exemption - Religious Beliefs**

This bill exempts from jury duty a person whose religious beliefs prohibit the person from serving on a jury.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Minimal. Any expense incurred in printing revised juror qualification forms could be handled with existing resources.

**Local Effect:** Minimal. Any expense incurred in printing revised juror qualification forms could be handled with existing resources.

Small Business Effect: None.

## **Analysis**

**Current Law:** The only persons who are exempt from jury service are:

- a member of the organized militia who is certified by the Military Department as a member; and
- a person who is 70 years old or older who has made a written request for an exemption.
