## Charles County - Bingo - Prizes and Hours of Operation

This bill increases from $\$ 1,000$ to $\$ 5,000$ the maximum value of a money prize that may be awarded in a single bingo game in Charles County and increases from $\$ 5,000$ to $\$ 10,000$ the maximum value of all money prizes that may be awarded by an organization at a single bingo event in Charles County. The bill also limits a bingo event to four hours per day.

The bill is effective June 1, 2003.

## Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.
Local Effect: Increasing the maximum value of money prizes in a bingo event conducted by a fundraising organization or an educational organization would not impact Charles County finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

## Analysis

Current Law: In Charles County the maximum value of a money prize that can be awarded in a single bingo game is $\$ 1,000$ and the maximum value of all money prizes that can be awarded in a bingo event in a single day is $\$ 5,000$. Any fundraising organization or educational organization may conduct a bingo event in Charles County. A fundraising organization or educational organization may not conduct bingo events at
one location on more than four days in any seven-day period or on three consecutive days.

Generally, jurisdictions in the State that permit organizations to conduct bingo have maximum limits on prizes awarded for a single game of bingo but do not have a maximum limit on the total prizes awarded in a bingo event.
