AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 780
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after “license;” insert “requiring a volunteer fire company to provide a certain notice to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene under certain circumstances;”; and after line 16, insert:

“BY adding to

Article - Health - General

Section 21-304.1

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2000 Replacement Volume and 2003 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 2, after “THAT” insert “ONCE A YEAR”; in line 3, strike “35” and substitute “30”; in the same line, strike “OR”; in line 4, strike “NONCONSECUTIVE”; and in the same line, strike “EACH YEAR”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 21, insert:

“21-304.1.

(A) A VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF AN EXCLUDED ORGANIZATION UNDER § 21-301(E) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT THE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY INTENDS TO SERVE FOOD TO THE PUBLIC FOR UP TO 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS.

(Over)

(B) THE WRITTEN NOTICE SHALL INCLUDE THE DATES ON WHICH THE FOOD WILL BE PREPARED, THE METHODS OF STORING AND SERVING THE FOOD, AND THE METHODS OR PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED TO ENSURE FOOD SAFETY AND SECURITY.”.
