AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "Junkyards" insert "<u>, Dumps, and Other Facilities</u>"; in line 4, after "of" insert "<u>certain</u>"; in line 5, after "junkyards" insert "<u>, dumps, and other facilities; requiring</u> <u>certain ordinances to be designed to achieve certain purposes; authorizing an ordinance to prohibit</u> <u>the operation or maintenance of certain junkyards, dumps, or other facilities in a certain location</u> <u>until a certain license has been obtained</u>"; in line 6, strike "the adoption of an" and substitute "<u>a</u> <u>certain proposed</u>"; in the same line, strike "regulating junkyards"; in line 7, after the first "a" insert "<u>certain</u>"; in the same line, strike "regulating junkyards"; in line 9, after "regulating" insert "<u>certain</u>"; in the same line, after "junkyards" insert "<u>, dumps, and other facilities</u>"; in the same line, after the first "a" insert "<u>misdemeanor, subject to a certain fine; authorizing the legislative body of a</u> <u>municipal corporation to declare a certain violation to be a</u>"; in the same line, after "junkyards" insert "<u>, dumps, and other facilities</u>"; in line 10, after "regulating" insert "<u>certain</u>"; and in the same line, after "junkyards" insert "<u>, dumps, and other facilities</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike beginning with "IN" in line 20 down through "(B)" in line 25; in lines 26 and 27, strike "OF JUNKYARDS"; in line 27, after "JURISDICTION" insert "<u>OF:</u>

- (2) <u>PUBLIC OR PRIVATE DUMPS;</u>
- (3) <u>AUTOMOBILE JUNKYARDS;</u>
- (4) AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER FACILITIES;
- (5) SCRAP METAL PROCESSING FACILITIES;

(6) OUTDOOR PLACES WHERE OLD MOTOR VEHICLES ARE STORED IN QUANTITY OR DISMANTLED; AND

(7) LOTS ON WHICH REFUSE, TRASH, OR JUNK IS DEPOSITED";

and in line 28, strike "(C)" and substitute "(B)".

On page 2, in line 2, after the second "AND" insert "<u>DETERIORATING</u>"; in lines 9 and 14, strike "(D)" and "(E)", respectively, and substitute "<u>(C)</u>" and "<u>(D)</u>", respectively; strike beginning with "INCLUDE" in line 9 down through "OPERATED" in line 10 and substitute "<u>PROHIBIT THE</u> <u>OPERATION OR MAINTENANCE OF A JUNKYARD, DUMP, OR OTHER FACILITY</u>"; in line 14, after "(1)" insert "<u>(I)</u>"; in line 19, after the period insert:

"<u>(II)</u>";

in line 20, after the first "THE" insert "<u>DATE</u>,"; in the same line, after "TIME" insert a comma; in line 21, strike "A" and substitute "<u>THE</u>"; after line 23, insert:

"(E) (1) <u>A PERSON WHO VIOLATES AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED UNDER THIS</u> <u>SECTION, INCLUDING THE MAINTENANCE OR OPERATION OF A JUNKYARD, DUMP,</u> <u>OR OTHER FACILITY WITHOUT A LICENSE, IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR, AND ON</u> <u>CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF AT LEAST \$25.</u>

(2) EACH DAY ON WHICH A VIOLATION CONTINUES IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.";

in line 24, after "(F)" insert "<u>THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION</u> <u>MAY DECLARE</u>"; in the same line, strike "IS" and substitute "<u>TO BE</u>"; in line 25, strike "AND" and substitute "<u>THAT</u>"; and in line 28, strike "October" and substitute "<u>July</u>".
