AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1310 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "requiring" in line 5 down through "information" in line 6 and substitute "<u>requiring certain community colleges to submit a request for proposal to the Maryland Higher Education Commission</u>"; in line 8, after "out-of-state" insert "<u>4-year</u>"; and strike beginning with "requiring" in line 9 down through "program" in line 10 and substitute "<u>requiring the Commission</u> to adopt certain regulations".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 27, strike "COMMUNITY COLLEGE" and substitute "<u>REGION OR</u> <u>STATE</u>".

On page 2, in line 3, strike "LOCAL" and substitute "<u>REGIONAL AND STATEWIDE</u>"; after line 3, insert:

"(<u>3</u>) <u>DETERMINE THE REGIONAL OR STATEWIDE NEED FOR</u> <u>GRADUATES OF EACH PROPOSED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM;</u>";

and in lines 4, 6, and 10, strike "(3)", "(4)", and "(5)", respectively, and substitute "(4)", "(5)", and "(6)", respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike beginning with "A" in line 11 down through "STATE" in line 12 and substitute "<u>THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION FOR DISTRIBUTION TO</u> <u>PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS</u>".

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 13 on page 2 through line 10 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

"(B) A COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAY SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR A SITE-DETERMINED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM PROPOSAL TO AN OUT-OF-STATE 4-YEAR INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION IF NONE OF THE PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS RESPOND TO THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE'S REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO OFFER A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM.

(C) AN OUT-OF-STATE 4-YEAR INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION RESPONDING TO A REQUEST FOR A SITE-DETERMINED BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAM FROM A COMMUNITY COLLEGE MUST SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE COMMISSION FOR APPROVAL.

(D) <u>IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE</u> <u>GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS</u> <u>NECESSARY TO FULFILL THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.</u>".
