AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 611

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Protective Headgear Requirement for”; in line 3, strike “Exceptions” and substitute “Licensing and Protective Headgear”; in line 4, after “of” insert “requiring an individual to provide proof of health insurance to the Motor Vehicle Administration to obtain a license to drive a motorcycle; requiring the Administration to establish a certain notification system;”; in line 6, strike “the requirement that protective headgear be worn by”; and in line 10, after “Section” insert “16-104.1(d) and”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 15, insert:

“16-104.1.

(d) (1) A Class M driver's license authorizes the licensee to drive motorcycles.

(2) An individual who is issued a Class M driver's license under this subsection may not drive or attempt to drive a motor vehicle on any highway in this State unless a Class M driver's license authorizes the individual to drive a vehicle of the class that the individual is driving or attempting to drive.

(3) (I) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT ISSUE A CLASS M DRIVER'S LICENSE TO ANY INDIVIDUAL UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL FURNISHES EVIDENCE SATISFACTORY TO THE ADMINISTRATION THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS CURRENT HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE.

(II) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH AND IMPLEMENT

(Over)

A SYSTEM FOR EACH INSURER OR PROVIDER OF THE HEALTH INSURANCE REQUIRED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH TO REPORT TO THE ADMINISTRATION ANY LAPSES IN HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL ISSUED A CLASS M DRIVER'S LICENSE."
